


# DLA DISTRIBUTION PERSPECTIVE

## "POLICY"

Not to continue to perpetuate "non-standard" interfaces or support changes that add to existing complexities. Serve as a catalyst to promote streamlined and standardized DMISA interfaces.

## ISSUES:

- ❖ Non-standard processes: decision to store (DSS) or direct ship (Maintenance); "how to" report receipt
- ❖ Excessive manual intervention – lack of PMR data and adequate documentation
- ❖ Non-standard system interfaces: follow AMCLs 12 (MILSTRAP) and 43 (MILSTRIP)



## **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

- Pre-positioned Materiel Receipt Data (PMRD)
  - DLSS (MILS) Transaction DW\_
  - Receipt Documentation key to matching PMRD record
  - Critical to Accurate and Timely Receipt Reporting
- Project Codes 3AB and 3BB
  - No special logic in DSS - simply perpetuated
- Single Air Force Owner RIC Change
  - Only DSS sites co-located with ALC
  - Affects ability to identify specific owner within service for DMISA materiel
