


How Supervisors Determine Employee Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Requirements



AFOSH 14.2.1 requires Supervisors to assess the workplace to determine hazards which necessitates the use of PPE

Consider all hazards associated with tasks the employee performs.

Definitive guidance includes Tech Orders, Work Control Documents. Ensure guidance covers all tasks including material handling. AFOSH 4.11 says "Manual material handling tasks will be evaluated using a JSA".

Use PPE Job Safety Analysis Certificate

PPE Job Safety Analysis provides input to the Job Safety Training Outline and AF Form 55

Supervisors should sign the PPE validation certificate, keep in supervisor book
