

## Supervisor PPE Validation

1. AFOSHSTD 91-501, Chapter 14, states: “The supervisor shall assess the workplace to determine if hazards are present, or are likely to be present, which necessitates the use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). If such hazards are present, or likely to be present, the supervisor shall conduct a Job Safety Analysis (JSA) to identify hazards and PPE required for a particular task”.
