**HOUSING YARD/GARAGE SALE PROGRAM**

**COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PUBLICATION IS MANDATORY**

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This instruction implements *AFPD 32-60, Housing*. This instruction provides policies, procedures, and responsibilities of yard/garage sales at Hill Air Force Base. It applies to all occupants of military family housing who initiate yard/garage sales in their quarters areas.

**SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

Permits family housing residents one yard/garage sale per year in addition to one prior to PCS; participants must obtain written approval three days prior to sale; and the Self-Help Store will provide two signs, one may be placed at the nearest intersection and the other in the yard. A | indicates revisions from the previous edition.

**1. GENERAL.** One yard/garage sale per year may be conducted in the Hill AFB military family housing areas. A yard/garage sale is also permitted prior to PCS and termination of base housing. Permission will be obtained from the Family Housing Management Division (75 CEG/CEH) by written request. Sale must be approved at least three days prior to the sale days.

**2. ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS.** The sales are open to military families and Department of Defense personnel possessing pass and identification papers. No civilians without prior-issued passes and identification will be allowed on base for the sole purpose of attending a yard/garage sale.

**3. SIGNS.** Standardized signs will be checked out from Housing Maintenance Self-Help. Only two signs are allowed for any sale and must be removed immediately after the sale. One sign may be placed in front of the unit and another at the closest intersection. No other signs are permitted.

**4. CLEAN-UP.** The yard/garage area will be cleaned up each night at, or prior to sunset.

5. **ADVERTISING.** Advertisement is limited to the "Hilltop Times."

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
