1.2.6.4. (Added) The Utah Test and Training Range Planning and Programming Board will approve all temporary site requests submitted to the Bureau of Land Management and will continue follow-on ratification by the Facilities Board.

(Added) Installation or Modification of Fire and Security System Policy was established for processing contracts involving installation or modification of fire and security systems to ensure system protection, compatibility and reliability. All contract packages or modifications should be forwarded to the Service Contract Unit, (775 CES/CEZL). Packages must include:

1.2.6.5.1. Statement of Work.

1.2.6.5.2. Cost Estimate.

1.2.6.5.3. AF Form 9, Request for Purchase.

1.2.6.5.4. Certifying Official Designation.

1.2.6.5.5. Wage Classification, Justification and Approval (if needed).

1.2.6.5.6. Quality Assurance Surveillance Plan (if needed).

1.2.6.5.7. Quality Assurance Designation Letter.

NOTE:

After the packages are reviewed to ensure system compatibility and accuracy of specifications, the packages will be returned to the requester if changes are required. If no changes are necessary, the packages will be forwarded to the Operational Contracting Division (OO-ALC/PKO) for processing.

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
