

Utah Test and Training Range (UTTR) Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Information



What is a RAB?


The Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) is an instrumental part of the environmental cleanup program at the Utah Test and Training Range (UTTR). Its purpose is to advise Hill AFB on community concerns regarding the environmental investigation and cleanup activities conducted under the Air Force's Installation Restoration Program at the UTTR. The UTTR RAB was formed in 2011 to encourage more community participation in the cleanup process and to allow community members and other stakeholders to have meaningful dialog with UTTR/Hill AFB environmental officials.

The RAB is comprised of community members, local government representatives, environmental regulators, Air Force representatives and other interested parties. The RAB is co-chaired by a member of the community (chosen by the RAB's voting members) and by an Air Force representative. The RAB has developed its own mission statement and operating procedures, and consults with the Air Force in developing meeting agendas. All RAB meetings are open to the public. Hill AFB provides administrative support for the RAB and pays for all necessary RAB meeting expenses.

RAB Membership Expectations

Community RAB members serve voluntarily, without compensation, for a two-year term. Members are expected to attend all biennial meetings or send an alternate in their place, and devote up to three hours a month on their responsibilities. RAB members will have an opportunity to review cleanup plans, program priorities and comment on technical doc-uments and reports. Members will act as a liaison between the community and the Air Force, and as such, should make themselves available to meet with members of their community. RAB meetings are typically held at 10 a.m. in the spring and again in the fall, typically held at the Tooele County Emergency Management (TCEM) building (15 E 100 S in Tooele, Utah).
