Canine Companions for Veterans by Dan Rutledge

You may have noticed someone going about their day with the assistance of a certified service dog. Such dogs assist folks with a disability that may not be readily apparent to an observer. However, without such a dog, life is more difficult for people with hearing loss, PTSD, or mobility impairment.

One such organization provides certified service dogs at no charge. Canine Companions is a national organization that leads the service dog industry in providing such dogs to enable their clients to live with greater independence.

They provide service dogs to adults, children and veterans with disabilities and facility dogs to professionals working in healthcare, criminal justice and educational settings. Since their founding in 1975, they have provided dogs and all follow-up services at no cost to their qualified clients.

Antelope Island Utah State Park

Historical Corner

The AMC M422/M422A1 Mighty Mite, weighing in at 1700 pounds, was 750 pounds lighter than the World War II Willy's Jeep!

After World War II, the Marines wanted an air droppable jeep, or one that could

be carried by a CH-37 helicopter. In 1959, AMC designed the M422 with an aluminum body and air-cooled 55HP V4 engine that, to-date, is still the lightest U.S. military truck ever made.

It boasted fully independent suspension, inboard brakes and could carry up to six troops or 850 pounds. At \$5,000 a pop they were not cheap, and the advent of turbine powered helicopters led to the early demise of the scrappy M422 and less than 4,000 were produced by 1962.

Reserve Component Survivor Benefit Plan Understanding RCSBP: Protecting Your Loved Ones

The Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) provides monthly income to survivors of retired military members when retired pay ends. For reservists, the Reserve Component Survivor Benefit Plan (RCSBP) offers similar protection, with differences in eligibility, cost, and coverage to reflect reserve service.

When to Enroll:

Once you receive your 20-year letter (Notification of Eligibility/NOE), you have 90 days to elect RCSBP coverage—regardless of age, health, or current military status. Even if you don't plan to retire yet, you must act within this window.

Spousal Consent Required if you:

- Decline coverage
- Choose children-only coverage
- Elect less than full (55%) coverage

Your Election Is Final

Your RCSBP choice is irrevocable unless you have a qualifying life event. If you don't submit a valid election, the law will assign one:

- No Dependents: Option A
- With Beneficiaries: Option C (Spouse Only cost applies)

RCSBP Options at a Glance:

- Option A Defer
- Decide at age 60. No premiums now. No coverage if you die before 60.
- Option B Deferred Annuity
- Coverage starts now, but benefits begin only at age 60.
- Option C Immediate Annuity
- Coverage and payments begin immediately after death.
