

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & RESPONSE

3 TYPES OF REPORTING

1. RESTRICTED

- This option is recommended for those wishing to confidentially report a sexual assault
- Sexual Assault reported only to a SARC, VA, military chaplain, or military health care provider
- Available only to military members, dependents (18+), and DoD USAF Civilian Employees
- The sexual assault is not reported to OSI or command/ investigation is not initiated
- Victim may receive medical care, advocacy, counseling and access to Special Victims Counsel (SVC) services
- Provides time for victim to consider available options
- Victim controls the release/management of personal information
- May choose a SAFE Kit/forensic examination
- Civilians not affiliated with USAF DoD and retired members are not eligible for a restricted report.

Note: If a victim reports the sexual assault to anyone in their chain of command, the restricted reporting option is no longer available.


2. UNRESTRICTED

- A report of sexual assault made by a victim through normal reporting channels (victim's chain of command, law enforcement, AFOSI or other criminal investigative service)
- Available to active and retired military, civilians, contractors, dependents and family members (age 18 & above)
- The sexual assault is reported to OSI and to command . An investigation will be initiated - no confidentiality
- The SARC will be notified and assign a Victim Advocate (victim's choice)
- Referrals made for resource and services (victim's choice)
- Victim may receive medical care, advocacy, counseling , and access to Special Victims Counsel (SVC) services
- Victim may request an Expedited Transfer (military only)
- May choose a SAFE Kit/forensic examination
- Details of allegation will be provided only to those personnel who have a legitimate need to know

3. INDEPENDENT

- Information about a sexual assault is disclosed to command from an independent or third-party source
- An official investigation may be initiated based upon an independent report
