

# SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & RESPONSE

## Reporting Options for Adult Victims of Sexual Assault

### Restricted

- Confidential report to the SAPR Office by the Victim
- Available to military members, dependents (18+), and DoD AF Civilian Employees
- The sexual assault is NOT reported to OSI or Command
- Victim may receive medical care (including SAFE kit), advocacy, counseling, and Special Victim's Counsel (SVC)
- May choose to go Unrestricted at any time
- Victim's may make a restricted report before or after an independent investigation is initiated
- Victim's may anonymously enter subject information into CATCH

### Unrestricted

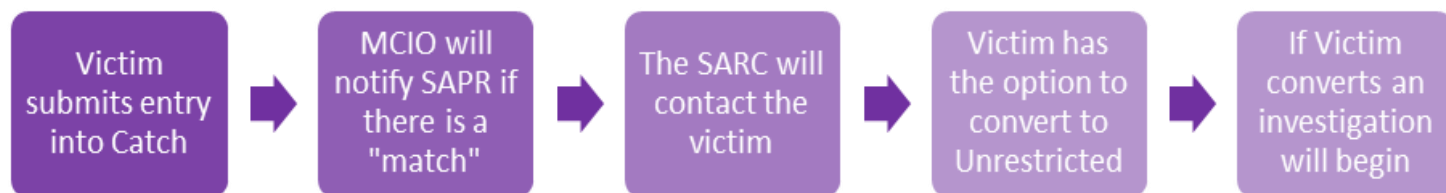
- Confidential report to the SAPR Office by the Victim
- Available to military members, dependents (18+), and DoD USAF Civilian Employees
- The Sexual Assault is reported to OSI & Command
- Victim may receive medical care (including SAFE kit), advocacy, counseling, and Special Victim's Counsel (SVC)
- Victim's may request an Expedited Transfer (military only) & Protective Order
- Victim's may anonymously enter subject information into CATCH if OSI is unaware of subject identity

### Independent

- Mandatory reporter is notified of a sexual assault by someone other than the victim (third-party report)
- Mandatory reporter will report the incident to the SARC, Squadron Commander (or equivalent), & OSI
- Victim has the option to opt out of the investigation
- Victim has the option to make a restricted report after Command & OSI are notified
- SAPR Office will neither confirm nor deny whether or not the victim has a restricted report

## CATCH a Serial Offender Program

Catch A Serial Offender: The CATCH Program gives people making a sexual assault report, where the name of the suspect is not known by law enforcement, an opportunity to anonymously submit suspect information to help the Department of Defense identify serial offenders. If there is a match the victim will be contacted by their SARC. For more information, contact your local Sexual Assault Response Office.



## Reporting Retaliation for Adult Victims of Sexual Assault

### Eligibility

Individuals who believe they have been retaliated against related to a report of sexual assault may report retaliation allegations including:

- Adult sexual assault victim who has previously made an Unrestricted Report of sexual assault;
- Adult sexual assault victim's adult family member
- Witness or Bystander (who intervened);
- SARC or SAPR VA on the case; or Responder
